As usual, there is plenty to see when it comes to self-propelled aerial work platforms, and this year is no exception in terms of booms and scissor lifts. One question is which manufacturer will have the largest boom lift at the show? You can be pretty certain that it will be one of three candidates - **Zoomlion**, **XCMG** or **Snorkel**. We do know that **Snorkel** will have its 210ft 2100SJ straight telescopic, which offers a working height of almost 66 metres. It broke the big boom record when it appeared as a prototype at Conexpo 2020. Six years on and with a few units in the field, the company is looking for wider take up.

Dingli has a big stand which will be packed. Check out the big boom lifts, with their modular construction and a choice of diesel, battery electric or hybrid power packs. When it comes to scissor lifts, if you have not already seen and tried the 'No Oil' models, then do so - the technology is now state of the art, at least for slab electric scissor lifts.

MEC is promising some radical surprise products but check the 135ft 135-RJ telescopic unveiled last year with its articulated rotating jib.

Skyjack's display will include the new 32ft slab electric scissor lift with direct electric drive, as well as the new 45ft SJ5545 E, its largest slab electric and the 40ft SJ6940 RT compact Rough Terrain scissor. You might ask about the new 85ft all electric Rough Terrain telescopic boom lift, the SJ28 TE+, for China and Southeast Asia.

At **JLG** check out the new 26ft micro scissor lift - the ES2632M - and its new generation of boom lifts. It will also stage live demonstrations of autonomous robotics and connectivity each hour.

As **Genie** enters its 60th year, it will focus on accessories and safety equipment, including 'Lift Guard', 'Zone Lighting', 'Lanyard alert' and 'Integrated Access Deck' on a 19ft GS-1932m micro scissor providing 19in/500mm of extra height for false ceilings etc...

Manitou will highlight its new scissor lifts and the 85ft telescopic boom lift, the company also has some interesting user accessories.

Sinoboom should have its new 15ft battery electric 0407ET oil-free scissor lift on the stand, which is well worth a look.

LGMG will launch a new 125ft T125J-2 telescopic, the ANSI/CSA version of the upgraded T38J-2 as well as an 18ft SS1932ER micro scissor lift.

Finally, don't miss **Hyrax**, a small Dutch company, which builds high quality self-levelling tracked boom lifts. Stop by and watch a demo.
