While Conexpo might not have the depth of tower crane exhibits we see at Bauma, there are some interesting exhibits and introductions and there is still plenty to see.

In terms of what's going on, an interesting stand will be **Terex**

**Cranes by Raimondi**. This is the first outing for the Terex cranes since it was acquired by Raimondi at the start of November. It is kicking off with the new 16 tonne CTT 392-16 flat-top tower crane with up to 75 metres of jib and a wide choice of towers. Sounds interesting. It will also show the CTL 702-32/712-45 luffer.



**Raimondi** has come a long way since KBW Holding acquired the company in 2014, and has big plans for the combined business, so worth stopping by for a chat.

Spanish manufacturer **Jaso** celebrated its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary last year and is now focusing heavily on new technology. One thing to look out for is its all new Horizon crane cab, launched last year and now in production.

**Liebherr** has chosen to show a self-erecting tower crane from its new K series - the 91 K - with its intelligent assistance system that, the company says, enhances precision, efficiency, and safety. It will be running live demonstrations, so see what you think.

On the **Manitowoc** stand, you will find the **Potain** line of tower cranes, as you might expect, but also it will show the Dutch built **Montarent** 4x4 wheeled chassis under a self-erecting Potain crane. The product has apparently sold well in North America - it is definitely worth a look.

**Comansa** will exhibit its new five tonne 6LC85 flat-top compact tower crane for urban job

sites with jib lengths to 52.5 metres with a 1.2 tonne jib tip capacity.

As for the Chinese manufacturers, given all their other products it is unlikely that we will see their tower cranes, but we might be surprised. **Sany, XCMG** and **Zoomlion** are all located in the Festival Lot so it will not be hard to spot any that do.
