**Link-Belt Cranes** will unveil the new 248 | V, the fifth generation of its 200 ton/181 tonne lattice boom crawler crane, at the show. The updated model features a new luffing jib remote controlled upper counterweight installation. Also, check the new telescopic.

**Manitowoc** is not revealing anything but is making a lot of noise about innovative new products. Will it include crawler cranes? Also check the Sennebogen-built Grove telescopes.

**Tadano** will have both telescopic and lattice crawlers on show - it says to expect more evolution than revolution. It will have the 400 tonne/440 ton CC24.400-1 lattice crane on the stand alongside its TC600 telescopic.

**Liebherr** has not mentioned crawler cranes, but it is hard to imagine that it will not have at least one mid-range model on show, as well as a telescopic.

**Kobelco** will have two of its lattice crawlers on display, but we are not sure which.

**PVE Cranes** is definitely a stand worth visiting. Based in the Netherlands, PVE rents cranes worldwide, but also manufactures rugged lattice crawler cranes with electric or diesel power. It will launch a new generation crane, the 200 tonne PVE American CC200.

Expect to see a telescopic crawler on the **Sany** stand, and possibly its new 200 tonne SCC2000A-EV electric lattice crawler.

**XCMG** will have an array of 35 machines on its stand, from excavators to wheel loaders and aerial work platforms. Whether there is space left for a crawler crane, who knows?

**Hoeflon** builds an interesting range of high tech, lightweight spider cranes and is gaining a significant following in Europe. If you are interested in smaller tracked cranes, then this stand is a must, as is the **Fascaan** stand, to see Jekko's latest models and also check out the controls and displays.

But if spider cranes are your thing its hard to beat the Japanese

cranes from **Maeda**, and on the **Spydercrane** stand **Unic**. They may not have some of the 'bells and whistles' of the Europeans, but they are easy to operate and just about bulletproof when it comes to reliability.

Finally, **SPT** is the leading Chinese spider crane manufacturer. Don't expect high tech, but price might well be a thing?
